This is a case of road rage. Complainant has stated that one Swift car

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hit his truck no. HR-63A 6797 and when he asked the car driver as to why they hit the truck, they started beating the complainant, his security guard and servant. Other persons also joined them and hit them. Their car numbers were noted as DL 9CAK1213, DL 5CK4739, DL 2CAP 2492 and one black bullet bike. Counsel for the petitioners submits that vehicles have been produced during the investigations. Learned APP submits that the petitioners were not known to the complainant and the injured, inasmuch as their TIP is yet to be conducted.

Keeping in mind the above facts, I am of the view that petitioners are not entitled to anticipatory bail. Applications are dismissed. Other miscellaneous applications also disposed of as infructuous.
