File is taken up today as 13th September, 2016 was declared holiday on account of Idu'l Zuha.

Petitioner has challenged the order dated 1st August, 2016 passed by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi whereby his request for grant of parole has been rejected, inter alia, on the ground that jail conduct of the petitioner was unsatisfactory as he was awarded punishment on 3rd March, 2016. A perusal of nominal roll shows that petitioner has been awarded punishment twice. First punishment was given to him on 3rd March, 2016; whereas second punishment was given on 29th March, 2016. Para 11.2 of the Parole/Furlough Guidelines, 2010 envisages that the conduct in prison must

have been uniformly good. Accordingly, writ petition is dismissed.
