ORDER
% 17.11.2016

(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.138/2014 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Welcome. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/victim amicably before Delhi Mediation Centre, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi.

(2) Respondent No.2-complainant is present before the Court along with her counsel. The Investigating Officer present in the court has

identified her. I have enquired from the complainant whether the matter has been settled with the petitioner amicably without fear and pressure. She has informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR. Pursuant to the settlement ₹60,000/- (in cash) have been handed over to the complainant today in the court. Statement of the complainant recorded separately. Divorce by mutual consent has been granted.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties. Order dated 25.11.2014 of Delhi Mediation Centre, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi, recording settlement between the parties is on record.

(4) Since the complainant/Respondent No.2 has voluntarily settled the dispute with the petitioner, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.138/2014 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at Police Station Welcome and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5) The petition is disposed of accordingly.
