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By the present petition the petitioner seek quashing of FIR No.708/2015 under Sections 392/34 IPC registered at PS K.N. Katju Marg on the complaint of respondent No.2.

Be that as it may, the offence alleged is punishable under Section 392 IPC. State of Punjab & Anr. (2012) 10 SCC 303.
