Learned counsel for the appellant, on instructions from the appellant and after seeking time for consideration after pass-over, states that the present appeal is not pressed, more so because the original judgment and decree was challenged by the appellant right up till the Supreme Court but the appellant was not successful, and, in fact the first appeal filed resulting in the impugned order dated 9th June, 2016 was not maintainable as the order of the learned trial Court dated 22nd October, 2013 itself was not appealable.
