1. Parties state that the Sale Deed has been executed before the Sub-Registrar, who is said to be not proceeding with the registration till the interim order passed by the Court is clarified.

2. It is clarified that the interim order passed on 26th August 2013 stands vacated by the subsequent order dated 18th March 2015 passed in CS (OS) No.1636/2013. Consequently, no interim order as such survives in the present suit.
