It has been contended by Mr. Rizwan, learned counsel appearing for the respondent Directorate of Education and also noted from the writ petition that the petitioner had earlier filed a writ petition being W.P.(C) NO. 1912/2016 which was disposed of on 8th March, 2016 with a direction to CBSE to dispose of the representation dated 20th July, 2015 made by the petitioner.

Noting the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn.
