By the present petition, the Petitioners seek quashing of FIR No. 5/2016 under Sections 354/506/509/34 IPC registered at PS Hauz Qazi, Delhi on the complaint of Respondent No.2 as the parties have settled the matter.

Respondent No. 2 is present in Court and is identified by the counsel and the Investigating Officer. She states that she has settled the matter with the petitioners and does not wish to pursue the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences of their own free will, volition and without any coercion and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

Consequently, FIR No. 5/2016 under Sections 354/506/509/34 IPC registered at PS Hauz Qazi, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed.
