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W.P.(CRL) Nos. 2832/2016 & 2847/2016

Petitioners and private respondents are neighbours. A quarrel ensued between them, in which both the parties sustained injuries resulting in registration of following cross FIRs:-

(a) FIR No. 236/2016 under Sections 308/34 IPC registered at P.S. Chhawala on the complaint of respondent no. 3 Ms. Sarika in W.P.(Crl.) No. 2832/2016.

(b) FIR No. 235/2016 under Sections 308/323/34 IPC registered at P.S. Chhawala on the complaint of respondent no. 4 Ms. Suman in W.P.(Crl.) No. 2847/2016.

Petitioners and private respondents have settled their disputes amicably vide Compromise Deed dated 24th August, 2016, inasmuch as they want to maintain harmonious relation in future. Complainants/injured in both the FIRs are not willing to pursue their respective FIRs. They are present in Court and have been identified by SI Satbir Singh, P.S. Chhawala.

Keeping in mind the fact that a quarrel ensued between the neighbours on some trivial matter, wherein injured persons sustained simple injuries and a compromise has been entered into between them, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the criminal proceedings

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pending. Accordingly, in the interest of justice both the FIRs, that is, FIR No. 236/2016 under Sections 308/34 IPC and FIR No. 235/2016 under Sections 308/323/34 IPC both registered at P.S. Chhawala, which are at the investigation stage, are quashed.

Both the writ petitions are disposed of in the above terms. Dasti.
