1. None appeared for the appellant on the last date of hearing; however adverse orders were deferred.
2. Today also Mr. Nishe Rajen Shonker, Advocate for the appellant has chosen not to appear and has sent Mr. Satheesh Mohanan, Advocate who does not know anything about the case and seeks passover.
