**W.P.(CRL) Nos. 2633/2016 & 2950/2016**

By these petitions, petitioners have prayed for quashing of following FIRs:-

(a) FIR No. 617/2015 under Sections 323/341/506/34 IPC registered at P.S. Jamia Nagar on the complaint of respondent no. 2

(b) FIR No. 364/2015 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC registered at P.S. Jamia Nagar on the complaint of respondent no. 2.

Petitioner no. 1 is the husband of respondent no. 2. Other petitioners are relatives of petitioner no. 1. Petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2 have settled their disputes amicably before the Counsellor of Family Court, Saket Courts, New Delhi on 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 on the terms and conditions as stipulated in the report dated 5<sup>th</sup> August, 2016 of the Counsellor. Report has been signed by the petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2. It is submitted that

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petitioner no. 1 has already pronounced *talaq*. Respondent no. 2 is present in Court and has been identified by SI Dinesh Kumar, P.S. Jamia Nagar. Respondent no. 2 admits having settled the matter with the petitioner no. 1. Petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2 submit that they will abide by the terms of the settlement, as contained in the report of Counsellor Ex. C-1. Respondent no. 2 has no objection in case both the aforesaid FIRs are quashed.

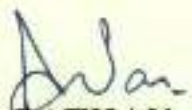
Keeping in mind the fact that both the FIRs are the outcome of marital discord between the petitioner no. 1 and respondent no. 2 and they have settled the matter, in my view, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep them entangled in the criminal proceedings. Accordingly, in the interest of justice both the FIRs, that is, FIR No. 617/2015 under Sections 323/341/506/34 IPC and FIR No. 364/2015 under Sections 498-A/406/34 IPC both registered at P.S. Jamia Nagar and the consequent proceedings emanating therefrom, are quashed.

Both the writ petitions are disposed of in the above terms. Dasti.
