Learned counsel for the respondent has produced the copy of the prospectus as well as the admission notice along with the cut-off marks. The same are taken on record.

Learned counsel for the respondent points out that the minimum marks required for registration, as notified by the respondent – University, were 200. She, however, submits that the cut-off marks for admission as on 20.08.2016 in the regular general category, to which the petitioner belongs was 234 and the last candidate admitted in the said category had a score of 215. For one remaining seat, the University has notified the cut-off as 214 and there are over hundred students who have registered for the same. The petitioner has also registered for it, however, the

score of the petitioner is 202.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the last student admitted had a score of 215 and the petitioner has a score of 202. She submits that no student below 215 has, till date, been admitted.

In view of the above, I find no merit in the petition. The petition is dismissed.
