CRL.M.C. 3448/2016

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.532/2014 under Sections 498A/506/34 IPC at PS Civil Lines. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Tis Hazari Courts, Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 26.05.2015.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with her counsel and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from

the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Pursuant to the settlement, a cheque bearing No.416903 dated 01.09.2016 in the name of the complainant for a sum of ₹2.5 lacs drawn on Canara Bank has been given to the complainant by the petitioners in the Court today.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 26.05.2015 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.532/2014 under Sections 498A/506/34 IPC at PS Civil Lines and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petitioners are directed to deposit ₹ 15,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
