Learned counsel for the parties submit that the learned Arbitrator has already entered upon reference and the arbitration proceedings are in progress and the next date before the Tribunal is 24th February, 2016. They agreed that the present petition be treated as an application under Section 17 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 by the learned Arbitrator. Ordered accordingly.
