Application is disposed of.

Marital discord between the husband and wife, that is, petitioner no.1 and respondent no.2, has led to the registration of the present FIR No.276/2015 under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC at police station Krishan Nagar against the petitioner no.1 and his relatives, that is, petitioner nos.2 & 3. Petitioners and respondent no.2 have reconciled their differences before

the mediation centre, Karkardooma Courts, Delhi and have started living together since 20th February, 2016. Respondent no.2 is present in Court and submits that in view of the settlement, she is not willing to pursue the FIR any further.

Keeping in mind the facts that husband and wife have reconciled their differences and they have started living together, no fruitful purpose would be served to keep the criminal proceedings pending. Accordingly, FIR No.276/2015 under Sections 498A/406/34 IPC registered at police station Krishan Nagar is quashed.

Writ petition is disposed of in the above terms.
