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This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No. 856/2014, under Section 135 EC Act, registered at Police Station Amar Colony. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably between the parties.

Status report has been filed by the State. Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has amicably settled the matter in dispute with the respondent No.2/BSES and the settled amount of Rs.78,400/- has already been deposited by the petitioner vide receipt No.040033115913 dated 27th July, 2016.

Counsel for the respondent No.2, on instructions, also confirms the factum of amicable settlement with the petitioner and submits that he has no objection if the FIR No. 856/2014 in question is quashed against the petitioner.

In view of the amicable settlement entered into between the parties, no useful purpose would be served in continuing with the criminal proceedings against the petitioner. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the FIR No. 856/2014, under Section 135 EC Act, registered at Police Station Amar Colony and all proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed.
