W.P.(CRL) 2786/2016

1. Present petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.1162/2015 registered under Sections 452/323/341/506/354/34 IPC at PS Malviya Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondents No.2 & 3 vide compromise deed dated 17.09.2016.

2. Complainant / respondents No.2 & 3 are present in person and have been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from them if they have settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably without any fear or pressure. They have informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with their free consent and they have no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of compromise deed dated 17.09.2016 has been placed on record. Cross case registered vide FIR No.1164/2015 under Sections 506/509/341/354/451/34 IPC at PS Malviya Nagar has also been settled and the FIR therein has been quashed. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.1162/2015 registered under Sections 452/323/341/506/354/34 IPC at PS Malviya Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petitioner is directed to deposit ₹ 20,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
