A statutory remedy lies against the impugned order. The learned counsel for the respondents submits that appropriate notification has been issued by the Govt. of NCT of Delhi on 06.08.2004 under Section 13-A of the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 apropos interpretation etc. of standing orders.
