It is the petitioner's case that she has been awarded "Average" gradings in the Annual Confidential Reports (ACRs) for the years 2009 to 2014; since the copies of the said adverse entries were never supplied to her, hence, the same cannot be acted upon. Her representation to respondent No.3 and to the Government of NCT of Delhi have not yielded any reply.
