Petitioner seeks parole on the ground that he has to file special leave petition in Supreme Court. Address of petitioner has been verified. It is trite to say that every convict is entitled to avail all the legal remedies as may be available to him upto the highest forum.

Keeping in mind the totality of circumstances, it is ordered that petitioner be released on parole for a period of one month from the date of his release, subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Jail Superintendent. During the parole period, petitioner shall

report to the concerned SHO once a week, that is, on Mondays at 10:00 am and give his contact number to the SHO. On completion of parole period, petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent Jail.

Writ petition is disposed of in the above terms. Copy of the order be sent to the Jail Superintendent for serving it upon the petitioner and for compliance.
