ORDER

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By the present petition, the Petitioner seeks quashing of FIR No. 364/2013 under Sections 354A/509 IPC registered at PS Vikas Puri, Delhi on the complaint of Respondent No.2 as the parties have settled the matter.

Learned APP for the State on instructions from Investigating Officer states that besides the Petitioner there is no other accused involved in the FIR and besides Respondent No. 2 there is no other complainant/victim.

Respondent No. 2 is present in Court and is identified by the Investigating Officer. She states that she has settled the matter with the petitioner and does not wish to pursue the above-noted FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto.

In view of the fact that the parties have amicably resolved their differences of their own free will, volition and without any coercion and no useful purpose will be served in continuance of the proceedings, rather the same would create further acrimony between them, it would be in the interest of justice to quash the abovementioned FIR and the proceedings pursuant thereto. There is no legal impediment in quashing the FIR in question.

Consequently, FIR No. 364/2013 under Sections 354A/509 IPC registered at PS Vikas Puri, Delhi and proceedings pursuant thereto are hereby quashed subject to the petitioner depositing a cost of ₹20,000/- with the Juvenile Justice Fund maintained by the Registrar General of this Court and ₹10,000/- to be paid to the respondent No.2 within two weeks. The receipt of both payments will be furnished by the petitioner within three weeks before this Court.

Parties have signed this order sheet in acknowledgment of their statements made before this Court.

The petition is disposed of. Order dasti.
