CRL.M.C. 4122/2016

(1) Present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been preferred by the petitioners for quashing of FIR No.1014/2014 under Section 135 Indian Electricity Act, 2003 and 379 IPC registered at Police Station Jamia Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/respondent No.2 amicably.

(2) Learned counsel for respondent No.2 / BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. is present before the Court and informs that the petitioners have

paid his all dues and respondent No.2 / BSES Rajdhani Power Ltd. has no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

(3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties.

(4) Since the matter has been settled between the parties amicably and the entire dues have been paid, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.1014/2014 under Section 135 Indian Electricity Act, 2003 and 379 IPC registered at Police Station Jamia Nagar and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.

(5). The petitioners are directed to deposit ₹ 15,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

(6) The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
