with consent that respondents-tenants shall vacate the tenanted premises on or before 31st August, 2016.

Learned counsel for petitioners states that despite the aforesaid consent, the respondents-tenants have not vacated the premises till date.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, this Court is of the opinion that the petitioners have an alternative effective remedy by way of execution proceedings.

Consequently, the present contempt petitions are disposed of with liberty to the petitioners to revive the execution proceedings already filed by them.

This Court directs the Executing Court to decide the execution applications filed by the petitioners at the earliest.
