Petitioner seeks parole, inter alia, on the ground of maintaining social ties and for repair of the house. It is trite to say that in case convict, in long incarceration, is released on parole once or twice in a year, the same is sufficient for him to maintain social ties. As regards repair of his house is concerned, the same also could have been undertaken by him in the month of June/July, 2016.
