ORDER

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The petitioners have filed the present petition seeking quashing of FIR No.617/2015 registered on the complaint of the complainant under Sections 498A/ 406/ 34 IPC and Section 4 of the Dowry Prohibition Act against the petitioners at Police Station – Kanjhawala.

The complainant is present in Court. She is identified by the learned counsel for the petitioner as well as by Mr. Raj Karan Sharma, who appears on her behalf. She has also produced her Aadhar Card, which has been shown to the Court and returned. A copy of the same is retained on record.

The parties have arrived at a settlement on 14.07.2016, which has been placed on record. Under the settlement, out of the total settlement amount of Rs.7,70,000/-, the complainant has already received an amount of Rs.4,70,000/-. An amount of Rs.3,00,000/- has been tendered to her in Court today. The complainant states that she has not been subjected to any pressure or coercion and that she has entered the settlement out of her own free will. The complainant further states that she joins the prayer for quashing of the FIR in question.

Accordingly, no useful purpose would be served in proceeding further with the FIR in question and the proceedings emanating therefrom. The same are hereby quashed.
