1. For the reasons mentioned in the application, the date is postponed.
2. The application stands disposed of.
3. The date already fixed in the matter i.e. 19th January, 2017 stands cancelled.

CRL.M.A.No.18602/2016 (Exemption)

Exemption allowed subject to all just exceptions.

The application stands disposed of.

CRL.M.C. 4452/2016

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.183/2010 registered under Sections 380/452 IPC

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at PS Adarsh Nagar. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Rohini Courts, Delhi vide settlement agreement dated 26.10.2016.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present with counsel and has been identified by her counsel. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioner amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 26.10.2016 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.183/2010 registered under Sections 380/452 IPC at PS Adarsh Nagar and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petitioner is directed to deposit ₹ 15,000/- as costs in the Prime Minister Relief Fund within two weeks. Registry shall ensure its compliance.

5. The petition stands disposed of accordingly.
