Notice. Learned Additional Standing Counsel accepts notice. Status report has been filed and taken on record. Petitioner seeks parole on the ground of filing Special Leave Petition in the Supreme Court. Learned Additional Standing Counsel submits that petitioner has given his address of Himachal Pradesh, which has been verified. It is further submitted that petitioner has also given address of his sister, who is living at House NO. 29, Krishan Vihar, East Main Khera Road, Najafgarh, Opp. R.P. Garden, New Delhi. For the purpose of filing Special Leave Petition, petitioner will have to stay in Delhi. It is trite to say that every convict is entitled to avail all the legal remedies as may be available to him upto the highest forum.

Keeping in mind the totality of circumstances, it is ordered that petitioner be released on parole for a period of one month from the date of his release, subject to his furnishing a personal bond in the sum of ₹10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of Jail Superintendent. During the parole period, petitioner shall not leave the territorial bounds of Delhi and provide his mobile number to the SHO, P.S. Najafgarh. He shall also report to SHO, P.S. Najafgarh once a week, that is, on Mondays at 10:00 am. On completion of parole period, petitioner shall surrender before the Superintendent Jail.

Writ petition is disposed of in the above terms. Copy of the order be sent to the Jail Superintendent for serving it upon the petitioner and for compliance.
