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Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in the memo of parties, the name of petitioner No.2 and petitioner No.3 has been given as Alok @ Bholu and Arun Kumar @ Bholu respectively, whereas the same should read as Alok @ Anoop and Arun Kumar @ Gholu respectively. The said correction has been made in Court today.

The petitioners have filed the present petition seeking quashing of FIR No.237/2013 registered on the complaint of the complainant under Sections 452/ 354/ 509/ 34/ 506 IPC against the petitioners at Police Station –

Kalyanpuri.

The complainant/ respondent No.2 is present in Court. She is identified by the Investigating Officer.

The parties have arrived at a settlement on 25.05.2016, which has been placed on record.
