1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.46/2011 registered under Sections 498A/406 IPC at PS Itchapuram Town, District Srikakulam, Andhra Pradesh, subsequently transferred to Delhi by orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is stated that the matter has been settled amicably with the complainant / respondent No.2 before the Mediation Centre, Supreme Court vide settlement agreement dated 29.04.2015.

2. Complainant / respondent No.2 is present and has been identified by the Investigating Officer. I have enquired from the complainant if she has settled the dispute with the petitioners amicably without any fear or pressure. She has informed that all the disputes between the parties have been resolved amicably with her

free consent and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR in question. Divorce by mutual consent has already been granted. Pursuant to the settlement, all the payments have been received by the complainant.

3. The petition is supported by affidavits of the parties. Copy of settlement agreement dated 29.04.2015 has been placed on record. Since the dispute between the parties has been settled, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to enable the parties to settle in life after divorce, FIR No.46/2011 under Sections 498A/406 IPC at PS Itchapuram Town, District Srikakulam, Andhra Pradesh and all the proceedings arising therefrom are quashed.

4. The petition stands disposed of accordingly. Pending application also stands disposed of.
