Counsel for the parties submits that parties have entered into an amicable settlement. An application under Order XXIII Rule 3 read with Section 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been handed over in Court. Registry is directed to list and number the application.

The plaintiff as also the Director of the defendant are present in Court. They are identified by their counsel. Parties submit that they have entered into an amicable settlement. They identify their signatures on the application. The application is also signed by the counsel for the parties, and is duly supported by the affidavit of the plaintiff and the Director/authorised representative of the defendant company.
