The present petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 11(6) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 for appointment of an Arbitrator.

Heard. With the consent of the parties, the prayer made in the petition is allowed. As agreed, the matter is referred to the Delhi International Arbitration Centre ('DAC') who will appoint an Arbitrator in accordance with the provisions of the Act. The Arbitrator to adjudicate the disputes arising out of the agreement in question between the parties as mentioned in the present petition. The parties are also allowed to file their respective claims and counter-claims before the Arbitrator.

The arbitration shall take place under the aegis of DAC. The Arbitrator shall ensure the compliance of the provisions of Arbitration and

Conciliation (Amendment) Act, 2015 before commencing the arbitration. The fees of the learned Arbitrator shall be in terms of the Delhi International Arbitration Centre (Administrative Cost Arbitrator's Fees) Rules.

The petition is accordingly disposed of.

Copy of this order be given *dasti* to the learned counsel for the petitioner and a copy thereof be delivered to the learned Arbitrator as well as Additional Coordinator, DAC forthwith.
