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After some arguments, learned counsel for petitioner wishes to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file an application under Regulation 37(2) of the Competition Commission of India (General) Regulations, 2009.

In the event, petitioner cooperates with the Director General, Competition Commission of India, the Chairman of the petitioner company need not be summoned.

With the aforesaid liberty and directions, present writ petition and pending application are dismissed as withdrawn.
