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The petitioners have filed the present petition seeking quashing of FIR No.149/2015 registered on the complaint of the complainant under Sections 498A/ 406/ 307/ 313/ 34 IPC against the petitioners at Police Station – Bara Hindu Rao.

The complainant is present in Court. She is identified by the Investigating Officer.

The parties have arrived at a settlement on 26.11.2015 in mediation,

which has been placed on record. The complainant has already received the entire amount of Rs.4,00,000/- under the settlement.
