1. The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.1077/2015 registered under Sections 323/342/376/506/511/120B IPC at PS Ambedkar Nagar. Status report is on record.

2. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties and have examined the file. By an order dated 07.01.2016 the petitioner was granted interim protection and was directed to join the investigation as and when required. Undisputedly, the petitioner has joined the investigation since then. The prosecutrix is present along with her counsel. They have no objection to the grant of bail as the matter has been settled between the parties.

3. The prosecutrix and the petitioner were acquainted with each other and allegedly performed marriage on 22.04.2015. The petitioner had filed W.P.(Crl.) 922/2015 which was disposed of vide order dated 21.05.2015. The prosecutrix declined to join the company of the petitioner.

4. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail and in the event of arrest, he be released on furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹ 50,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of the SHO/Investigating officer. He shall, however, join the investigation as and when required.

5. The bail application stands disposed of.
