W.P. (Crl.) No. 3045/2015

(1) Present writ petition under Article 226 of Constitution of India has been preferred by the petitioner for quashing of FIR No.798/2015, under Sections 354A/354D/506/509 IPC registered at Police Station Timarpur, New Delhi. It is stated that the matter has been settled with the complainant/respondent No.2 amicably.

(2) Respondent No.2-complainant is present before the Court with her counsel. The Investigating Officer present in the court has identified her. I have enquired from the complainant whether the matter has been settled with the petitioner amicably without fear and pressure. She has informed that the matter has been settled without any fear or pressure and she has no objection to the quashing of the FIR.

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- (3) The petition is supported by the affidavits of the parties.
- (4) Since the petitioner has voluntarily settled the dispute with the complainant, no useful purpose will be served to continue with the proceedings. In the interest of justice and to put an end to the litigation, FIR No.798/2015, under Sections 354A/354D/506/509 IPC registered at Police Station Timarpur, New Delhi and all the proceedings emanating therefrom are quashed.
- (5) The petitioner is, however, burdened with cost of ₹20,000/- to be deposited with Prime Minister National Relief Fund within two weeks. The Registry shall ensure the compliance of the order.
- (6) The petition and all pending application (s) stand disposed of accordingly.
