This is an application under Section 482 Cr.PC moved by the petitioners for cancellation of non-bailable warrants issued by the Trial Court.

Since in this application, petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail, application for cancellation of non-bailable warrants issued by the learned Trial Court is not maintainable before this Court.
