2 20-07-2017 Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and learned
APP for the State.

The petitioner seeks bail in Kalyanpur P.S. Case No.
34 of 2017 registered under Sections 8, 20(b)(II)(B), 22, 25 and 29
of the N.D.P.S. Act.

The petitioner is said to have loaded 4 Kg of ganja in
his auto after unloading from a truck and the said ganja was
recovered from his auto by the police.

It is submitted by learned counsel for the petitioner
that the petitioner happens to be mere driver of the said auto. He
has no concern with the seized ganja. The recovered ganja is much
less than the commercial quantity. He has no criminal antecedent.
He has been languishing in custody since 16.03.2017.

Considering the recovery of aforesaid quantity of



contraband from the possession of the petitioner, I am not inclined to enlarge the petitioner on bail. Accordingly, prayer for bail of the petitioner is rejected.

Learned lower court is directed to dispose of the case as expeditiously as possible within six months from the date of receipt or production of a copy of this order.
