From the narration of facts in the order dated 04.07.2016, it is obvious that the litigation on behalf of the present petitioner was being carried out in a lacklustre manner according to his convenience.

Since the Tribunal works strictly in accordance with the procedure and the rules laid down, the refusal of the Tribunal to restore O.A. or to condone the delay in absence of satisfactory explanation having been offered and the condonation application not having been filed within reasonable time, the Tribunal has committed



no error of law.

The impugned order dated 04.07.2016 is not required to be interfered with. The writ is dismissed.
