Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner it is directed that in case, apart from his grievance in the matter of granting encashment of leave, the petitioner has any further claim arising out of contract of service entered into between him and the respondent-Bank, liberty shall be available to the petitioner to raise all such claims before the competent authority of the Bank and the competent authority of the Bank shall consider and take a decision in accordance with law within a period of two months of its presentation, needless to emphasis that we have not expressed any



opinion on the merit of the claim and it will be for the competent authority of the Bank to take action as per law.

With the aforesaid modification in the order passed by the learned Writ Court, the appeal stands disposed of.
