In the present case, petitioner is claiming for
appointment on the post of Nayay Mitra in Gram Panchayat
Raj Jankidih under Chanan Block in the district of Lakhisarai.

Petitioner is claiming that he should be appointed as
Nayay Mitra which is not a civil post. Respondent no.9 has
been appointed as Nayay Mitra the scheme provides forum before the
Sub Divisional Officer to raise the issue against any wrong has been



done to her which the petitioner has not availed.

As it is not a civil post the writ petition does not lie inasmuch as petitioner has not challenged the selection of respondent no.9.

In such view of the matter, this writ petition does not survive and accordingly the same is dismissed.
