This application has been filed seeking appropriate
orders directing the respondents to recognize the degree of Baby
Teachers certificate awarded by Hindi Vidyapith, Prayag, Uttar
Pradesh, on the ground that they were issuing such certificates
before coming into force of National Council for Teachers



Education (NCTE) Act, 1993.

Firstly, I do not find any substance in the claim raised by the petitioner. Secondly, this application has been filed under an apprehension that the said certificate will not be recognized by the authorities, which cannot be basis of issuance of prerogative writ.

This application has no merit. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
