2 16-08-2017 Some dues of the petitioner has been paid by the respondent Bank while some are yet pending and the petitioner complains of non-compliance in view of the order passed in CWJC No.16125 of 2006 and the directions contain therein.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and considering the Special Bench judgment of this Court since reported in **2014(1) PLJR 695 (The Organizer, Dehri C.D. & C.M. Union Limited vs. The State of Bihar)** and since as per the own admission of the petitioner present at paragraph 4 that



some of his dues has been paid by the Bank whatsoever the grievance yet subsist, the petitioner would be at liberty to approach the statutory authority under the Bihar Cooperative Societies Act for the redressal of the same.

The contempt application is disposed of accordingly.
