This public interest writ petition has been filed by the petitioner seeking a direction to the respondents to provide facilities in favour of teaching and non-teaching staff of sanctioned Intermediate private Colleges and grant financial aid to them.

The colleges in question for which the benefit is sought are private self financed institutes and in a public interest writ petition, we cannot issue a mandamus for providing an aid to such an institute. The institutes, if entitled for the aid, should approach the concerned authority and this Court at the instance of the petitioner cannot issue a



mandamus for granting an aid to a private institute.

Accordingly, finding no ground to make any indulgence into the matter, the writ petition stands dismissed.
