Heard learned counsel for the petitioner and counsel for
the State.

In the present case, the petitioner has claimed return of
the security money for the financial year 2011-12 as well as
transportation bill for the period February, 2012 to March, 2012 and



from May, 2012 to August, 2012 as the petitioner has worked as Transport and Handling Agent in the district Lakhisarai.

Let the petitioner should file a detailed representation before the respondent no.5, the Deputy Chief of Claim, Bihar State Food and Civil Supply Corporation who will consider the grievance of the petitioner and take a decision in accordance with law.

If the petitioner files a representation to the aforesaid authority, he will be obliged to give a hearing, only thereafter, he will pass a reasoned order and if the authority arrives to a finding that certain amount is payable to the petitioner, it goes without saying that the B.S.F.C. will release the said amount within a period of three months after the decision of the Authority.

With the aforementioned observation and direction, this application is disposed of.
