of the writ application. Now final order has been passed. It is
apparent from the order dated 18.11.2017 passed by the

appended with the show cause affidavit as Annexure-D that the petitioner did not come at the time of measurement, however, measurement has been taken and some deviation has been found and the builder has been noticed with regard to that.

Thus, in my view, this contempt proceeding cannot continue further and is, accordingly dropped.

However, the petitioner if so advised, would be at liberty to assail Annexure-D to the show cause affidavit before a competent forum.
