direction to the respondent authorities to take necessary action
against private respondent nos. 5 to 8 and to conduct the

Learned counsel for the petitioner prays for disposal of the present writ application with a direction to respondent no.4, the Circle Officer, Bihiya to get the land in question measured and demarcated.

Learned A.C. to G.P.-15 submits that he is not having any objection to the confined prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner.
