ORAL ORDER

7 22-03-2017 A supplementary show cause is being filed on behalf of the Circle Officer, Sugauli and by placing on record the order-sheet in the encroachment case, it is stated that the order of this Court directing disposal thereof, has been complied. Let it be taken on record.

Although Mr. Satish Chandra Jha, learned counsel for the private respondents endeavours to submit that the encroachment has not been removed in totality but in my opinion in view of the order-sheet reflecting a disposal of the



encroachment case, no cause is made out to continue with the contempt application. The party aggrieved by the disposal may move before the appropriate forum by filing appropriate application, for contesting the position reflecting from the order-sheet of the encroachment case.

The contempt application is disposed of accordingly.
