The petitioner filed this petition for quashing of the order
of suspension as contained in Memo No. 389 dated 2nd of April, 2016
(Annexure-3).

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order
of suspension is based on non-est ground. It is further submitted that
the departmental proceeding was initiated and the enquiry officer has
already submitted the enquiry report.
