Writ Application is now disposed of with a direction that the petitioner will be paid Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand) per month from the pension which he is entitled to, till a sum of Rs. 2,13,857/- (Two Lacs Thirteen Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Seven) finally stands adjusted from the account of the petitioner.



The Court is informed that with this arrangement it will take about 18 months to wipe out the outstanding amount as noted above.

The order will take effect from 1st December, 2017 till the adjustment is made.
