As such the jurisdiction exercised under Article 227
of the Constitution of India by the writ court with regard to the order
passed by the Additional District Judge, Patna City, in a succession
proceeding with regard to withdrawal of the amount by the appellant
without giving any share to the persons entitled, we are of the
considered view that the learned writ court has dismissed the writ



petition in its supervisory jurisdiction and therefore, no interference is called for.

This appeal under clause-10 of the Letters Patent is not maintainable. It is, accordingly, dismissed.
